Class Shipley Visit to Ponderosa

On Tuesday 9th July 2024, Class Shipley will be going on a trip to Ponderosa.

Class Shipley will be learning all about the wonderful world around us, and most importantly how to look after it! The trip to Ponderosa will teach children about the importance of conservation and how to ensure the survival of different species. During the trip, the children will have to opportunity to see over 140 different animals including black and white ruffed lemurs, wallabies and marmosets!
