

## Year I Spring Term Science



## Key Vocabulary

leaf: one of the usually green, flat parts of a plant or tree that grows from the stem or branch.

flower: the part of a plant that has petals and that makes fruit or seeds

blossom: the flower of a plant which forms a seed or fruit

petals: one of the separate leaves that form the outer part of a flower head

fruit: the part of a plant that has seeds and flesh

roots: he part of a plant that usually grows underground.

seed: the small part of a flowering plant that grows into a new plant

branch: a woody part of a tree or bush that grows out from the trunk

trunk: the main stem of a tree.

stem: the main part of a plant that grows up from the ground and supports the branches, leaves, flowers, or

fruits that may grow from the plant.

## Science

To start the term we will be looking at the season of 'Winter' and comparing what the weather and area around us is like, compared to 'Autumn'.

We will be looking at a variety of plants and learning how to describe them based on their characteristics.
