English

In English, we will continue to develop our sentence writing.

We will use a variety of texts to inspire and develop our sentence writing skills including capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We will also look at rhyming words using the text Oi Dog and begin to add suffixes to words with the help of the books; Ten Little Penguins and the book Snowball











This half term our focused author is Kes and Claire Gray. One of their well-known books is Oi Dog. **Scanthe QR code to listen to OI Dog!**






Maths

This half term, our focus is on deepening the children's understanding of addition and subtraction.

We'll be introducing the part-whole method to support their learning, helping them apply it to both addition and subtraction problems. As their confidence grows, they'll begin exploring how to add to and subtract from a given number.



In addition, we'll continue to strengthen key number skills, including:

Subitizing (instantly recognizing quantities without counting)
Counting forwards and backwards to 20

Finding doubles up to 10 Halving numbers up to 20

Religious Education

In RE we will be answering the question, 'Why does Christmas matter to Christians?'

We will be learning more about the Christmas story and the important visitors who travelled to Bethlehem to visit Jesus in the stable. On the run up to Christmas, we will be thinking about how Advent is an opportunity to prepare for Jesus' birthday and the good news he brought.
