




Year 5 Curriculum Overview 2025-2026 Autumn 2

This half term we will be exploring the texts:







We will explore these texts to discover different writing styles and

Children will explore how to write effectively for different purposes and use simple devices to structure the writing and support the reader – such as writing an informal letter, nonchronological report, persuasive advert and poetry

In addition, children will take part in many discussions and chances to speak aloud in class to explore the topic and genres uncovered throughout the texts.

Maths

This half term we will be focusing on:

- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division
- Fractions

We will be moving on addition and subtraction, exploring adding and subtracting with four-digit numbers, round and use the inverse operations to check answers.

Additionally, we will further explore multiplication and division looking at: multiples, factors, prime, square and cubed numbers. As well as this, children will delve into multiplying and dividing by 10. 100 and 1000.


Finally, we will explore fractions- find equivalent fractions, convert improper fractions to mixed numbers and vice versa. Children will also develop their skills in adding and subtracting fractions as well as mixed numbers











Religious Education

This half term in Religious Education, children will be exploring the key question: 'What does it mean if God is holy and loving?

They will learn that: Christians believe God is omnipotent. omniscient and eternal, and that this means God is worth worshipping. Christians believe God is both holy and loving, and Christians have to balance ideas of God being angered by sin and injustice (see Fall) but also loving, forgiving, and full of grace. They will also look in the belief that Christians do not all agree about what God is like, but tru to follow his path, as they see it in the Bible or through Church teaching.
