








English	Maths	Religious Education
<p>In English, we will continue to develop our sentence writing and build on this by beginning to write sequences of sentences.</p> <p>We will be looking at using adjectives to describe nouns and begin to join sentences using the conjunction 'and'.</p> <p>Over the half term we will have the chance to do lots of writing in other areas of our learning including our own 'That's not my' book linked to science and non-fiction writing linked to China.</p> <div data-bbox="349 890 663 1114"></div> <p data-bbox="376 1168 658 1203">Author of the half term</p> <p data-bbox="421 1235 591 1270">Sue Hendra</p> <div data-bbox="192 1305 819 1449"></div>	<p>This half term, we will continue our work with numbers to 50 moving on to 100, exploring how they are made and building confidence in reading, writing, and representing them.</p> <p>We will keep developing our number skills by grouping and sharing in 2's 5's and 10s to answer problems. After this we will begin to look at fractions of shapes and amounts, with our focus being halves as two equal parts and quarters as four equal parts.</p> <p>We will carry on practising our counting skills. We will be counting all the way to 100 and Miss Briggs will be challenging us to find one more, one less, say if it is odd or even and even count backwards,</p> <p>In our measurement work we will be looking at weight, thinking about which object is heavier or lighter and beginning to record the weights of objects.</p> <p>We will continue learning to tell the time. Miss Briggs will work with us every day ,telling the time to the hour ('o'clock') and moving on to 'half past' when we are ready.</p>	<p>In RE we will be answering the question,</p> <p data-bbox="1532 507 2047 542">Who is Jewish and how do they live?</p> <p>This half term we will explore texts from the Torah and their importance for Jewish people today. We will find out about the mezuzah and the Shema prayer and what they mean for believers. Later in the half term we will find out about Shabbat and Chanukah, discussing why Jewish people mark these times, what they learn from stories found in the Torah and why they are important today.</p> <div data-bbox="1473 817 2110 858"><h3>Reminders</h3></div> <p>Reading records need to be in school every day! We change reading books on a Wednesday and Library books on a Monday.</p> <p>PE is on Monday and Tuesday – children need to come to school in their PE kit.</p> <p>On Friday, children will receive a homework task this will often be practical and shared on class dojo or on a sheet in your child's reading file.</p>

<p align="center">Materials</p> <p>In Science we will be developing our understanding of everyday materials by learning to name objects, identify what they are made from, and explain why certain materials are used for specific purposes. We are also learning to describe materials using their properties, such as hard or flexible. We will be scientists by making predictions and suggesting ways to test materials.</p> 	<p align="center">What is it like to live in Shanghai?</p> <p>In Geography, we will be looking at the country of China and city of Shanghai. The children will develop their place knowledge of Shanghai and use their understanding of human and physical features to compare the city, to the city of Bradford. They will learn about Chinese culture including language, food, clothes and animals which you may find in the country.</p> 	<p>In Phonics, we have recently moved onto our phase 5 phonemes. We will be going over many sounds already learnt in preparation for our Phonics Screening Check. – we will be introducing alien names and spend lots of time playing games whilst practicing our reading. Each child will continue to read three times per week with an adult in school, and reading books will be changed every Wednesday.</p> <p align="center">✦ Snuggle Up Stories Bag ✦</p> <p>Every time your child reads at home and has their reading record signed; they'll earn a chance to take home the Snuggle Up Stories bag. The more they read, the more chances they have!</p>	<p>This half term, Mr Murrell will continue to coach us in PE once a week. We will be focusing on fitness and will teach us lots of new skills to develop co-ordination and balance, speed and stamina. Finishing the unit by taking part in some circuits.</p>  <p>With Miss Briggs we will be working on our throwing and catching skills, whilst learning some skills linked to the sport Netball.</p>

<p align="center">Pitch – high and low notes.</p> <p>In music we will be looking pitch through the theme of superheroes. We will learn how to spot high and low notes and use this to compose our own superhero music!</p> 	<p align="center">Digital Imagery</p> <p>In computing we are continuing to look at developing our photography and image editing skills. We will use these images to create an adventure story!</p> 	<p>In PSHE, we will be reading</p>  <p>We will be learning how all families are different. We will look at how families can change and different feelings this may cause us to feel. Finally we will be learning how everyone deserves respect.</p>	<p align="center">Sculpture and 3D Art</p> <p>In Art we will be creating 3D sculptures using paper. To do this we will learn a variety of ways to fold, scrunch and roll paper. Once we have mastered these skills the children will use their amazing imaginative skills to create a surprise 3D model!</p>
